The Autumn Gathering of the ECMTA will take place on November 8-10 2019, Leiston Abbey, Suffolk, UK, in cooperation with our host and partner Pro Corda. The delegates are invited to arrive on the evening of Fri 8th of November. The activities will start in the morning of 9th of Nov and end on lunchtime Sunday 10th of November.

Accommodation:

Our host for the weekend Pro Corda offers accommodation as follows:

full board for 130 GBP per delegate (approx. 145 Euros), inclusive rate for 8-10 Nov 2019.

Delegates who would like to stay one more night in Leiston Abbey after the Gathering, are welcome to do so - please make the additional payment for **B+B for 10-11 Nov, for 40 GBP (approx 45 Euros)**. You can pay the whole amount 190 euros for 8-11 Nov in one payment.

About Leiston Abbey:

Leiston Abbey is a beautiful historic site dating from 1363, set in the Suffolk countryside only a short drive from the seaside towns of Aldeburgh and Southwold. The beautiful abbey ruins are incorporated into the buildings providing a stunning backdrop. Parts of the ruins were purchased in the 1970s by Pro Corda, the International Chamber Music Academy, a charity running music courses for children and adults.

Directions to Leiston Abbey from London:

Trains go from London Liverpool Street (Central, Circle Line tubes) roughly every hour on the hour. You board the Norwich train and transfer at Ipswich (journey time is 1 hour 7 minutes). At Ipswich you board the Lowestoft train and disembark at Saxmundham (journey time is 38 mins). There is a short layover of approximately 15 minutes at Ipswich but you'll need to change platforms so the time is welcome! Should you wish to reserve your ticket there are very good deals on <https://www.greateranglia.co.uk/> and the earlier you book, the better. Train times can be viewed on www.nationalrail.co.uk There is a taxi rank at Saxmundham Station and the fare to Leiston Abbey is approximately £10.00 depending on number of people and luggage.

Useful tips:

1. When you get to Saxmundham with the train, **dial this number for ordering a taxi** (taxi to Leiston Abbey will cost 10 GBP): **A2B taxis +44 1728440310, Hart Cars 01728 602009, Squirrel Taxis 01728 602344.**
2. **Don't forget the adapter plug for your electronic devices**, you will need it in UK.
